The School of Oceanography offers numerous need-based and merit-based undergraduate scholarships including:

- Awards monetarily equivalent to three quarters of in-state tuition
- Awards of up to half of a student's estimated financial need
- Book awards of \$1000

Scholarship winners will be announced by the end of Spring Quarter. Eligible undergraduates are limited to matriculating Oceanography majors in good academic standing who will be enrolled for at least two quarters during the 2011-2012 academic year (summer, autumn, winter, or spring). Students receiving financial aid should contact the UW Financial Aid Office regarding how winning a scholarship might affect their award.

- a one-to-two page personal statement (see page 2)
- a copy of your unofficial UW undergraduate transcript (including Winter 2011)
- copies of other college-level transcripts (if appropriate).
