



Freshman Scholarship Application 2011-2012

The School of Oceanography offers numerous need-based and merit-based undergraduate scholarships including:

- Awards monetarily equivalent to three quarters of undergraduate in-state tuition
- Awards of up to half of a student's estimated financial need
- Book awards of \$1000

Applications for freshmen scholarships are accepted and funds are awarded **on a rolling basis**. Interested students are encouraged to apply as soon as they have been admitted to the University of Washington. Scholarship recipients must enroll in the School of Oceanography and make satisfactory progress towards a degree in Oceanography. Students receiving financial aid should contact the UW Financial Aid Office regarding how winning a scholarship might affect their award.

- a one-to-two page personal statement (see page 2)
- a copy of your high school transcript
- copies of other college-level transcripts (if appropriate).
